

CASE STUDY RESIDENTIAL APARTMENTS

Sportsman Mews, Hackney, London.

Installed by Abseilers Vital Access working as sub contractors for Igrox Ltd.

Heavy infestation of pigeons to the main south facing roof pitch. Previously three plastic flying falcons and spikes to the gutter line were installed. Avishock was viewed as the least obtrusive deterrent. The installation of 191m of Avishock Flex-Track, Straight Connectors, Quick Tap Jumpers and one Large Energiser was carried out over two days. The large amount of fouling on the pitch first had to be removed to allow for a perfect adhesion of the track.

Two rows of track were used butted up to each other on the triangular ridge. The pitch rows were spaced 1m apart.
